Ibn Taymiyyah may Allah have mercy upon him said: The people are **tools**, thus look towards the One who sent them against you. And don't look at their actions against you. **Indeed Allah only sent them against you due to your sins.** As Allah the Exalted said: "And whatever of misfortune befalls you, it is because of what your hands have earned. And He pardons much." (Soorah Ash-Shūraá 42:30)

When the person acknowledges the fact that everything that befalls him from the affairs he hates is due to his sins, then he will busy himself with repentance and seeking forgiveness from the sins that sent these people against him; instead of focusing on blaming those sent against him. If you see a person criticizing the people when they harm him and not returning to himself with criticism and seeking forgiveness, then know for sure that his calamity is a true calamity. But if he repents, seeks forgiveness and says 'this is due to my sins'; then this calamity will become a blessing for him.

Ali ibn Abi Talib may Allah be pleased with him said: "The slave only places his hope in his Lord, and the slave does not fear anything except for his sins." And he said: "No calamity has been sent down except due to sins, nor is it lifted except by repentance." End quote. Taken from 'The pillars of patience'
