Zayn ad Deen **Abu Faraj Abdur Rahman** ibn Abdul Haleem ibn Taymiyyah رحمه الله

Born 663 Hijri

Died 747 Hijri

He studied knowledge and Hadith from a number of scholars. Al Hafidh al Birzāli mentioned 86 of his scholars. He was a merchant with good religion. He kept close company with his brother Shaykh al-Islam due to his love for him and selflessness in aiding him.

Sharaf ad-Deen **Abu Muhammad Abdullah** ibn Abdul Haleem ibn Taymiyyah رحمه الله

Born 666 Hijri

Died 727 Hijri in Damascus

He sat under a large group of scholars. He studied the various methodologies until he became proficient. He was likewise proficient in Islamic inheritance jurisprudence, mathematics, astronomy, the foundational sciences, and the Arabic language. He was an Imam in history. He abstained from the worldly pleasures and was known for his piety. His brother Shaykh al-Islam used to honor him. He debated some scholars of rhetoric from Egypt and completely silenced them and obliterated their argument. Shaykh Abdur Razzaq al-Badr said when he presented the proofs and evidences to the scholars of rhetoric their only recourse was to request he change the subject.
