

Plague will not enter Madinah during the time of Dajjal

Explained by Shaykh Uthaymeen (Died 2001)

Question: Plague and the Dajjal will not enter Madinah, are the borders of Madinah known? Meaning is it known that city limits are from here to here?

Shaykh Uthaymeen: What is apparent is that "*Madinah*" applies to what will be called Madinah during that time, not during the time of the Messenger peace be upon him. It refers to the time when the Dajjal appears. The boundaries of Madinah when the Dajjal appears may be wider than it is now or it may be narrower. We do not know. This appointed time is not known to us. The borders of Madinah today are vastly wider than it was during the time of the Messenger. The Messenger peace be upon him would ride heading out towards the town of Quba, and there was a distant between it and Madinah, now it's in the same city. Therefore we do not know. Will Madinah shrink, or will it increase? What is important to know, is that the area that is referred to as Madinah during that time, plague or the Dajjal will not enter it.
