

## Companions whose Dua was always answered

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

- Al-Bara ibn Malik رضي الله عنه the brother of Anas ibn Malik

Anas ibn Malik رضي الله عنه said The Prophet ﷺ said: “How many are there with disheveled hair, covered with dust and given no significance; but if he were to swear an oath by Allah; He (Allah) would surely fulfill it”. Among them is Al-Bara ibn Malik.<sup>1</sup>

- S’ad ibn Abi Waqas رضي الله عنه

The Prophet ﷺ said: “O Allah, answer Sa’d when he supplicates to You”.<sup>2</sup>

S’ad ibn Abi Waqas was from the first and foremost to embrace Islam. He was the same age as Talha, az-Zubayr, and Ali.

- Habeeb ibn Maslama رضي الله عنه

Habeeb was twelve years old when the Messenger of Allah ﷺ died. Habeeb was nicknamed ‘Habeeb of Rome’ due to the great number of battles he fought there. He is mentioned from those whose supplication was answered.

- Saeed ibn Zayd ibn Amr رضي الله عنه

His mother Fatimah bint B’aja was from the first and foremost to embrace Islam. His father Zayd died upon the religion of Ibrahim two years before revelation descended upon the Messenger of Allah ﷺ. The Messenger of Allah ﷺ was asked about the condition of Zayd. He said: “He will be raised on the Day of Judgment as an Ummah unto himself”.<sup>3</sup>
